Hello everybody,

The past six weeks have been very busy here in the primary school. We have had several field trips and completed a number of projects.

The most recent trip was to Topola. All year groups went together by bus. It was a super day out and well worth the hours drive. Serbia is rich with history and is a very fascinating place. It was good for the children - both Serbian and those from other parts of the world - to see the depth of Serbian history as well as the beautiful countryside and the relaxed atmosphere of village life.

As part of a study about ancient Rome year three children went to Kalemegdan fortress and into the War Museum. We can all recommend this museum as being well organized and informative. It gives the visitor a brilliant insight into the long and complex history of the Balkans. A guide and an interpreter are helpful additions if you really want to understand things.

One visit which was very profitable was to the Money Museum. Year 4 went to visit this museum. The tour illustrated the development of money in Serbia. The children saw coins from ancient times to the present day. There was also a display of bank notes. This collection showed the highest value bank note printed in Yugoslavia. There was also a safe which contained 5 gold ingots and a golden necklace that several girls would have loved to have worn. Afterwards they had their photographs taken and then printed on a bank note! Everyone had a happy time and discovered much about the development of money.

Key Stage two children have been out as well they went to a Theatre at Banovo Brdo to watch the play 'Tom Thumb'. Everybody enjoyed themselves immensely.

The primary section finished term two with a 'fun sports' afternoon. There was a lot of silliness involving balloons, eggs and water. I humbly apologise if your child came home wet and grubby. However from the excitement and laughter I saw and heard I believe that they had a lot of fun.

The primary compound is beginning to take shape and as one project finishes another begins. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Robin and Ana's grandfather, **Mr. Jocić**, for his gift of four plants to the school. Ultimately a school is an environment - and if children are to spend 6 to 7 hours a day working and playing there - then it should be pleasant and friendly. A nice garden is essential. The afternoon of the Bazaar reinforced this when I saw people with their children taking advantage of the grounds and the play equipment.

Primary School Education visit to Topola and St George's Church/ Obrazovna poseta osnovne skole Topoli i Crkvi Sv.Djordja

The Primary school recently went on a school outing to Topola. This is a small town in the Oplenac Hills. The museum tells the story of the rise of two important Serbian families and their importance in the revolts which they led against the Ottoman Empire.

The coach journey was not a very long one. This was a benefit because very young children find traveling long distances difficult. The journey from Belgrade to Tolola was just right. We journeyed through some very pleasant countryside. It was a clear day and it was not long before the Oplenac hills came into view.

We arrived and got off the coach and went into the museum grounds. There was a statue to Black George. The story about this historical person was told to the children. The tour of the museum was interesting because it showed all kinds of artifacts from this period.

Afterwards we walked through parkland to St George's Church. The children found a good place to sit on the grass. They ate lunch and took the opportunity to buy an ice cream.

Eventually it was time to visit the church. This was a very special place. We entered a most beautiful church. The children's exclamations of wonderment said it all. There were two tombs on either side of the church.

One was for Black George and the other was Peter the first. Down stairs was the family mausoleum. Here were the remains of many family members. King Peter the II was not here. He is the only royal to be buried in the United States.



We had an interesting walk through the park and then we went back to where our bus was parked and set off back to school.

The day had been a sunny and warm spring day. As the bus began its journey back to school the weather changed and it started to rain. We were thankful that the good weather had held until our return to school. It was a very pleasant, relaxed and interesting day in which everyone learnt about the history of Serbia.

Students win Silver at InfoMatrix 2007/ Ucenici osvajaju srebro na InfoMatrix-u 2007

On Saturday 12th May if you had been at Belgrade's main train station you would have seen two teachers and two students from BIS board the overnight train heading for Bucharest. We were off to the 5th InfoMatrix International Computer Exhibition/Competition [www.infomatrix.ro]. Thirteen hours later we gratefully descended from the sleeping carriage (not having had too much sleep) but eager to get things ready for the public and the judges to view the students work on Monday and Tuesday.



Alongside students from as far afield as Mexico, South Africa and Mongolia we set up a professional display at the prestigious Law Department building of Bucharest University, along with the other twenty stands competing in the High School Computer Art section, and around eighty stands altogether.



The BIS students, Alex and Dejan, had produced for the competition a 3D project in Maya entitled "Interior", depicting the inside of an apartment they had once seen in Tunisia. Whilst this work looked simple, to make it look simple had taken many months of hard work in the after-school Maya club BIS runs.

From 9 until 6 on Monday and Tuesday our students had a stream of both school and university students as well as other members of the public coming to talk to them about their work. During this time they also had Computer Art judges; all professionals in this field visit them to assess the quality of their stand.

Just before lunch on Tuesday the two students were summoned for a viva with the judges. They first showed a one-minute film of their work created whilst they were preparing things at BIS, followed by a five minute live demonstration of how they created their scene, and then five minutes of questioning by the judges. At the end the students were relieved to get to lunch!

On the Wednesday in the modern central hall of the Law Department the Rector of the Bucharest University honoured the BIS students by presenting them with Silver Medals for their work. An excellent achievement for our students.

We survived the train journey home and the following day in a special assembly all the students at BIS congratulated Alex and Dejan on their wonderful achievement. event.

Ucenici nase skole Aleks i Dejan su za ovo takmicenje napravili 3D Maya projekat pod nazivom "Enterijer" prikazavši unutrašnjost apartmana koji su jednom videli u Tunisu. Mada ovaj rad izgleda jednostavan, bilo je potreno uloziti mesece rada u okviru van skolskih aktivnosti u 3D Maya klubu da bi on upravo tako jednostavno izgledao.

Od 9 pa do 18 casova nas tim je razgovarao sa rekom ucenika i studenata kao i publikom koji su dolazili da sa njima prodiskutuju o njihovom radu. Tokom ovog vremena takodje su imali i posetu sudija iz kompjuterskog dizajna; svi profesionalci iz ovog posla su ih posetili da bi procenili kvalitet njihovog standa.

Upravo pre rucka, u utorak, dvojica ucenika su bila pozvana na intervju sa sudijama. Oni su prvo prikazali svoj rad kroz jednominutni film koji je napravljen dok su se pripremali u nasoj skoli, zatim je sledila petominutna demonstracija uzivo o tome kako su kreirali svoju scenu, i zatim pet minuta ispitivanja od strane sudija. Na kraju su ucenici odahnuli i otisli na svoj rucak.
